Television and Wi-Fi

DSTV can be enjoyed when you connect with your own DSTV login details via the internet to DSTV / TV available. The TV is turned on and off by pressing the red button on the top left of the remote control.

Uncapped Wi-Fi on a Fibre connection is available

Please do not unplug or alter any electronica in the house, this includes the television, decoder and Wi-Fi.

<u>Refuse</u>

General waste should be put in the large bin in the kitchen.

If you are here on a Monday morning please put any bags out at the roadside by 8am. Do not leave bags out overnight as the seagulls (and other wildlife) will rip the bags open. Should you wish to recycle, the nearest recycling point is at the Recreation Club - it would appreciated if you could utilise this facility during your stay.

Patío Furniture

Please remove the cushions and bring them in at night to protect them from the damp sea air. Please ensure that the umbrella is put back in the house at the end of your stay.

<u>Barbeque</u>

Braai wood can be purchased from the Liquor store, the Spar or at the entrance to the Caravan Park during peak times. Please do not leave your fire unattended and do not throw warm ash in the dustbin.

Please make sure that any fire or smouldering wood is extinguished when finishing your barbeque and do not leave any fires unattended.

Pets

Voetjieshang do not allow any pets on the premises or in the house.

Blinds

We request that guests open and close the blinds with care.

Carefully roll them up and down on the rollers. Do not leave the blind down when the front door is open.

<u>Folding Doors</u>

How to open and fold up the panels of the large folding-glass door:

Start to open the door from the kitchen side.

Pull the handle <u>in</u> the middle of the panel and push the pin <u>up</u>.

Pull the handle in, push the pin down.

How the close the door:

Start in the corner at the bookshelf.

Pull the handle in and push the pin up.

Pull the handle in and push the pin down.
